Etiquette

Welcome to Collingtree Park Golf Course

We would respectfully ask you to ensure that you observe the following code of practice during your visit at Collingtree Park golf club.

Dress Etiquette

1. It is your responsibility to ensure that all of your guests, non golfers as well as golfers are correctly attired.
2. No jeans, trainers, tracksuits (tops or bottoms) rugby or football shirts may be worn on the course or in the clubhouse. Shirts must have a collar and sleeves. Trousers may not be tucked into socks. The removal of shirts is not permitted on the golf course.
3. Ladies may not wear strapless tops or low-scoop necklines.
4. Both players and non players must wear proper golf shoes on the course.
5. Indoors, golf shoes may be worn in the Pro Shop, and spike bar but not in any designated 'no spike' areas, i.e. Restaurant area.
6. Shorts when worn, must be tailored and can be worn with sports socks, no tennis or sports shorts are permitted. Ladies shorts must also be tailored and can be worn with ankle or bobble socks.
7. No waterproofs allowed in the bar area.
8. Golf bags are not allowed in the clubhouse area.
9. Changing of clothes in the car park is not permitted.
10. Members and guests must comply with the dress regulation in force in the dining areas.
11. Mobile phones are not permitted inside the clubhouse and should be switched off at all times.

Golf Course Etiquette

1. Tee times must be adhered to at all times. All visitors are asked to ensure that their guests are aware of their confirmed starting time and adhere to them. Any player missing or late for their tee time will be reverted to the next available tee time.
2. All play must be from the yellow tee markers, unless alternative arrangements have been made prior with the Club Professional.
3. Slow play is not tolerated. 4 hours is allowed for each match to complete the course.
4. Mobile Phones are not permitted on the golf course.
5. Players searching for a lost ball should invite the following match to play through.
6. All bunkers should be raked after playing out and rakes replaced in bunkers.
7. Replace divots and press firmly down.
8. Repair pitch marks on the greens.
9. Clear the green as soon as possible (i.e. mark scorecards on the way to the next tee).
10. Behave in a proper fashion on and off the course and do not give offense to Members or others.
11. Adhere to the rules of the golf club and local rules.

Use of Trolleys & Buggies

1. Buggies must stay to the cart paths and only be driven at a 90 degree angle to the ball in play. Under no circumstances should the buggy be driven down the fairway. This rule is at the discretion of the Head Greenkeeper and will be decided on a day to day basis.
2. Buggies must be kept on the cart path at all times under wet weather conditions, please check the rules of the day with the Club Professional when hiring.
3. Trolley bans are also at the discretion of the Head Greenkeeper according to course conditions. His decision is final. Please respect this.

Priority on the course

1. Any match playing a full 18 holes has priority over a match playing a 9 hole round.
2. A club competition match has priority.
3. If a match loses one clear hole to the one in front, it should allow the match behind to pass. Faster groups should be invited through.
4. Four is the maximum number allowed in any one game.
